

World Service Opportunities

There are multiple ways to serve at the world level in Debtors Anonymous.

Appointed Committee Members (ACMs) serve as voting members of committees of the General Service Board. Members meet once a month and work on special projects in the interim. The term is three years to serve as an ACM, with a maximum of two terms.

Project Contributors (PCs) work on one special project for an agreed-upon period of time. They are welcome to attend related Board committee meetings, but it is not a requirement. The term is typically 3-9 months to serve as a PC, although it can be longer.

General Service Board (GSB) Trustees have fiduciary responsibility for the management of the incorporated non-profit of Debtors Anonymous. They often serve between 4-10 hours per week and more. The term is three years with a maximum of two terms.

Typically ACM and GSB Trustee candidates possess general skillsets with experience in fields relevant to board committee work. Project Contributors offer special expertise, such as in book translation, book publishing, copy editing, magazine layout, manual writing, information technology, event planning, policy development, office management, human resources, accounting, finance, legal, or more.

To apply, candidates should prepare the following materials:

- **Signed Letter of Intent** stating interest, that the candidate meets the requirements, and providing contact details including full name, address, telephone number, and email address.
- **Service/Professional Resume** showing prior D.A. service and any professional qualifications or experience that may be helpful to the GSB committee.
- **Signed Letter of Recommendation** in the form of signed letter from the nominating person, group making the nomination, or another D.A. member who knows the applicant.
